Important Dates for FY19 and FY20 MIPPA Grants

- 9/29/21: End of Project Period for FY19 Tribal MIPPA No-Cost Extension Grants
- 11/30/21: Annual SF-425 Due for FY20 Tribal MIPPA Grants
- 12/28/21: Final SF-425 and Program Report Due for FY19 Tribal MIPPA No-Cost Extension Grants
- 8/31/22: End of Project Period for FY20 Tribal MIPPA No-Cost Extension Grants



Grant Requirements

- Conduct one community outreach event on MIPPA benefits
- Disseminate one community announcement on MIPPA benefits
- Submit a program/narrative report
- Submit a SF-425 financial report



Expenditure Ideas (this is not an exhaustive list)

- Development and printing costs for outreach materials (such as fact sheets, brochures, newsletters, calendars, postcards etc.)
- Items connected to the distribution of information (i.e. Pens, Folders, Note Pads, etc.)
- Meals and expenses for staff and volunteers
- PPE and other personal care items needed to work safely during the pandemic and beyond
- Promotional items related to [Medicare Preventative Benefits](#)
- Providing food and refreshments to staff and volunteers while they are conducting outreach events
- Radio advertisements about MIPPA
- Travel
- Training



Allowable costs

- Any costs—direct (equipment, supplies or services) or indirect (administrative, salaries, overhead)—associated with the production of a community outreach event and community announcement to promote the use of Medicare benefits for low-income beneficiaries.
