If you are currently selling, or plan to sell, your farm products directly to consumers, then what better way to advertise your market than through a public directory! It costs you nothing, and it may give your farm the advantage it needs to succeed in a competitive marketplace. It will allow the public to quickly search and locate your farm operation, and it will give them all of the information they need to buy goods directly from you!

How do I register my farm for publication?

It's easy! If you are a member of a federally recognized tribe,* then visit: olderindians.acl.gov/on-farm-market-directory

Once there, you will find a simple form to complete and submit to our office for publication in USDA's Directory.
